28. COMMUNICATIONS WHILE RACING

Add

- (c) The Race Committee may authorise a Boat to receive outside help in the form of technical advice relating to the repair or maintenance of the Boat or equipment from any source including from another Boat. This changes RRS 41.
- (d) All data on and off the Boat shall be copied to the duty officer;

Remove

30. POSITION REPORTS AND STEALTH PLAY

- (a) Race Headquarters will attempt to send a fleet position report to all *Boats* at approximately 0115, 0415, 0715, 1015, 1315, 1615, 1915 and 2215 UTC only. Failure to receive such information is not grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.1(a). The Duty Boat shall, as soon as possible, relay this report to any *Boats* with Inmarsat C failure.
- (b) If automated position reporting fails, the *Boat* shall report its position, course, speed, wind speed and wind direction at 0045, 0345, 0645, 0945, 1245, 1545, 1845 and 2145 UTC to Race Headquarters via a satellite communication system, failing that, to the Duty Boat via radio.

30. POSITION REPORTS AND STEALTH PLAY

- (a) Race Headquarters will attempt to send a fleet position report to all *Boats* at approximately 0115, 0415, 0715, 1015, 1315, 1615, 1915 and 2215 UTC only. Failure to receive such information is not grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.1(a).
- (b) If automated position reporting fails, the *Boat* shall report its position, course, speed, wind speed and wind direction at 0045, 0345, 0645, 0945, 1245, 1545, 1845 and 2145 UTC to Race Headquarters via a satellite communication system.
